This perspective, published in **STEM CELLS Translational Medicine**, addresses workforce development in regenerative medicine, providing an overview of the skills needed for the technical workforce and an assessment of the current skills gap between the skills needed and those present in the incumbent workforce or available in the labor market. The article will inform faculty development, curriculum development and alignment, RM work-based learning, and efforts to develop a diverse and inclusive workforce. It will also provide rationale for federal and state workforce development policy and investments.
